Sorensen Bridge project

The Sorensen Bridge replacement project, at Milepost 2.5 on Blaine Road, continues to move forward. The contractor, Holm II, has been working for the past year constructing the new bridge immediately upstream of the existing bridge.

The contractor opened road traffic to the new bridge June 7. While the contractor installs guard rails and striping, traffic will be controlled by flaggers.

Representatives from Holm II do not anticipate significant traffic delays during this work. After the new bridge is complete, then Holm II will start removing the old bridge structure. The entire project is scheduled for completion this fall.

This bridge replacement was funded 100 percent by a grant

from the Oregon Transportation Investment Act awarded to the County and the Oregon Department of Transportation in 2004.
