COUNTY ROADS DETERIORATE

Public Works Director, Aaron Suko, expresses his concerns over the toll winter weather is taking on our County roads. Responding to high water, mud and debris slides, downed trees, ice and snow is keeping your road crews very busy. The moisture, the freezing temperatures and the winter traffic are causing increased deterioration. The increased numbers and severity of pot holes and edge drop-offs that are being created concern us. We have a supply of cold patching material and have started making repairs, but it will take a while to catch up. It will take even longer if we are diverted to respond to additional storm events. We are working on the County roads to make repairs as quickly as we can and ask all drivers to be alert and drive safely."
