CASCADE TRACE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT STATUS

The contractor for the replacement of Cascade Trace Bridge is scheduled to start on-site construction on July 15, 2002. Cascade Trace Bridge is located off of Slab Creek Road approximately 3 miles southeast of Neskowin.

The contractor is Ross Brothers from Salem. ODOT is administering the contract for the County.

Initial contractor activities include mobilization of equipment and materials to the project area. In the several weeks following start of work, there will be several one day or shorter bridge closures to enable the contractor to complete required work. During these short closures there will be a pedestrian bridge available for local residents to use.

The \$187,000 bridge replacement project is funded with 80% federal funds, 10% state funds and 10% County matching funds. This project replaces the existing bridge which is the only cross river public access for the local community. The existing bridge is failing and currently has a load restricted weight limit.

Further information regarding the schedule of bridge closures will be provided directly to the Cascade Trace neighborhood in the near future.
