TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS PROPOSED FOR TILLAMOOK COUNTY

A meeting is scheduled at the Tillamook PUD Building, on January 9, 2003, from 4 PM to 6 PM to discuss projects in Tillamook County proposed for the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). This is an opportunity for the public to learn about the scope and schedule of projects planned between now and 2008 by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT).

The following projects will be discussed:

Pavement Preservation:

- OR HWY 22, US 101 to Castle Rock, pavement overly.
- OR HWY 131, Netarts Highway, US 101 to Ocean Street, pavement overlay with some shoulder widening.
- US 101, Manzanita to Wheeler, pavement overlay.

Modernization:

- US 101, North Tillamook, Suppress Road to south of the Wilson River Bridge, construct bridge and modernize roadway.
- OR HWY 6, at Wilson River Loop Road, construct interchange.
- US 101, at Long Prairie Road, improve intersection.

Bridge and Culvert:

- US 101, Wilson River (Tillamook) Bridge, repair and improve vertical clearance.
- OR HWY 6, Fall Creek Culvert and Bridge, replacement.
- OR HWY 6, Runyon Creek culvert, replacement.

Operations:

US 101, Jetty Creek (milepost 47.2 to 47.5) realignment.

This is an opportunity for all of us to learn more about these projects and express our priorities for their inclusion in the STIP.
