ROAD SIGN DAMAGE

We are asking for the public's help in putting a stop to the ongoing activity of traffic sign vandalism. Replacing signs takes money away from needed repairs to our roads and, during that time between when the sign is pulled down and when we can get a replacement up, drivers are at risk. If you witness any traffic sign vandalism please call 911 at once. McCORMICK LOOP ROAD REPAIRS The County Public Works Department is planning a repair project on McCormick Loop Road between Grandview Heights Road and Beeler Road. Work is scheduled to begin on Monday October 13, 2003 and will continue, during daylight hours, Monday though Friday, until completed. During much of the work time, traffic will be limited to one lane. We request that you use alternate routes to avoid the work area. If you must pass through the work area be prepared for delays, obey signs and follow the instructions of flaggers.
