COUNTY ROAD DAMAGE

The rains and winds of this past month have caused numerous problems on the county's roads. County workers have removed trees, rocks, mud and dirt from roadways, many times at night, week-ends and on holidays. The high water and flooding of the last two weeks has caused plugged culverts, shoulder erosion and an increase in the number of pot holes on the roads through out the County.
