Last May, Tillamook County opened bids for the Long Prairie Road/U.S. 101 intersection improvement project.

Intersection project status

The low bid was 37 percent over the project estimated costs. Being short project funds to award a contract, the Board of Commissioners decided to reject all bids.

Since then, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) and Tillamook County have been searching for funds to make up the shortage and enable this project to go out to bid again. Recently ODOT acquired additional

funding.

Presently the project is scheduled for bid opening in early November. Bid advertisement will begin in October.
