ORDER

#08 - 110

This matter came on to be heard this 17th day of December, 2008 at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners, at the request of Liane Welch, Tillamook County Public Works Director.

Being fully apprized of the records and files therein, the Board of Commissioners finds as follows:

1. Tillamook County is not liable for failure to improve local access roads or keep them in repair, but may spend County moneys on local access roads only if it determines that certain conditions exist, as specified in ORS 368.031.
2. The Tillamook County Director of Public Works has recommended, with the approval of the County Road Advisory Committee, the expenditure of County moneys for the following work on local access roads:
 - A. The installation and maintenance of stop signs requiring only a small expenditure of County moneys will result in a large improvement to the public safety.
 - B. Performing small projects necessary to reopen roads blocked by storm activity.
 - C. Inspecting bridges as well as maintaining, repairing, and posting appropriate signs warning of dangerous bridge conditions.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:
