

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 33,
Township 1 and 2 North, Range 5 West, W.M.,
Tillamook and Washington Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

6" Hemlock bears N13°E 42 lks.; now 21" stub 5 ft.
high, scribes 1S visible.

36" Fir bears S70°E 16 lks.; now 40" snag, face
grown over.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY," 1/4 S33 S4
1954 RS82, "35" in the ground, and from which a:

36" Fir stump bears N53½°E 43.5 ft.; scribed 1/4
S33 BT RS 82.

41" Fir stump bears S11°E 58.5 ft.; scribed 1/4
S4 BT.

Fir stump BT.

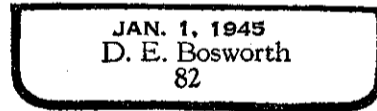
2" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SE of pipe.
