

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14,
Township 1 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook
County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 3" Vine Maple bears S61°W 9 lks.; now missing, clump of vine maple in place.
- 4" Vine Maple bears N54°W 59 lks.; now missing, clump of vine maple in place.
- 24" Fir bears N7°E 38 lks.; now 28" snag, exposed R7W S12 BT scribes.
- 40" Fir bears S42½°E 13 lks.; now 44" snag, scribes S R7W S13 BT visible.

RESTORED

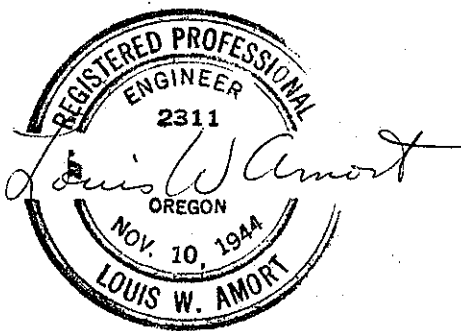
Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R7W S11 S12 S14 S13 1954 RE 2311," 34 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 47" Fir snag bears S15°W 14.2 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S14 BT RE 2311.
- 40" Fir snag bears N77°W 32.6 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S11 BT.
- 14" Fir snag bears N55°E 17.4 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S12 BT.
- 72" Fir snag bears S81½°E 46.6 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S13 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on original 40" Fir BT.
Also poster on 47" Fir snag BT.
4" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of pipe.
