CHAINS

Restored Corner for Oregon State Board of Forestry

One quarter corner common to Sections 23 and 24  
Township 2 North, Range 8 West, W.M., Tillamook  
County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL:

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 48" Larch bears N81E 56 lks.; now 63" stub 25 ft.  
high, 4S BT scribes visible.
- 52" Larch bears S35W 28 lks.; now 52" stub 45 ft.  
high, BT scribes visible.

RESTORED:

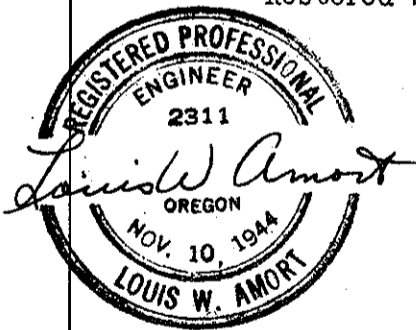
Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap  
marked (OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S23  
S24 1954 RE 2311, " 34" in ground, in mound of  
stone, from which a:

- 41" Fir snag bears N12E 121.3 ft.; scribed 1/4  
S24 BT RE2311.
- 34" Fir stump bears S4W 121.7 ft.; scribed 1/4  
S23 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster  
on 34" BT stump on South edge ridge road. Set  
4" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SE of pipe.  
Also poster on 36" Hemlock on North edge firebreak  
road #8 S24E 54 ft.
