

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 34 and 35,
T2N, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

12"x10"x10" stone, found out of place, from which a:

5" Fir bears N17°W 14 lks.; now 13" stub 5 ft. high
BT scribes remaining.

4" Fir bears S88°E 39 lks.; now missing.

RESTORED

Erected mound of rock around original in place with $\frac{1}{4}$
on W face, from which a:

11" Fir snag bears N64°W 22.4 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT RE 2311.

10" Fir snag bears N61°E 65.3 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT.
