

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter Section corner common to Sections 2 and 11, T3N, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

ORIGINAL

Stone 13" x 8" x 6", now in place 1/4 on North face, from which a:

16" Hem. bears N12°W 13 lks.; now 20" uproot, 26 lks. distance, root hole in place, 1/4 visible.

60" Fir bears S36°W 26 lks.; now 60" stump, 13 lks. distance, upper face cut off, BT visible on lower face.

RESTORED

Erected mound of stone around original, from which a:

49" Fir stump bears N31°E 5.1 ft.; scribed 1/4 S2 BT

37" Fir stump bears S19°E 23.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S11 BT RE2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 37" Fir stump BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 84" White Cedar post 2 ft. NW of 1/4 stone. Old tag on original 60" fir stump.
