

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One-quarter section corner common to Sections 5 and 6,
Township 3 North, Range 6 West, W.M., Tillamook County,
Oregon.

ORIGINAL

stake, now missing, from which a:

48" Fir bears S46°45'E 13 lks.; now 49" stump,
scribe S visible, rest unexposed.

18" Fir bears N74½°W 18 lks.; now just roots
remaining in place.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY ¼ S6 S5 1955 RE 2311,"
34 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

38" Fir stump bears S86°W 20.4 ft.; scribed
¼ S6 BT RE 2311.

Set 4" x 4" x 65" white Cedar post 1.5' SW of pipe.
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 38"
Fir stump BT.

Old General Land Office poster on Original 49" Fir stump BT.
Also poster on 4"x4"x72" white Cedar post on N bank of
road 240 feet N.
