

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, T3N, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

8" Hemlock bears S65 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¹⁰W 19 lks.; now 13" x 4" high stub, portion of scribes $\frac{1}{4}$ S remaining.

6" Hemlock bears S48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¹⁰E 31 lks.; now 14" uproot lying face down out of place, root hole in place.

RESTORED

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¹⁰

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 S4 1956 RS 359," 35 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

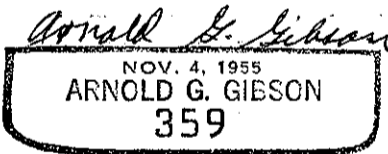
5" Fir bears S51⁰W 12.1 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S4 BT RS 359

6" Hemlock bears S4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ¹⁰E 31.2 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 BT.

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1 ft. SW of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 5" Fir BT.
