North one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 25 and 30
T3S, Rges. 9 and 10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Var. $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S25
S30 1957 RS 359," 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

16" Fir bears $S54^{\circ}W$ 107.0 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S25 BT.

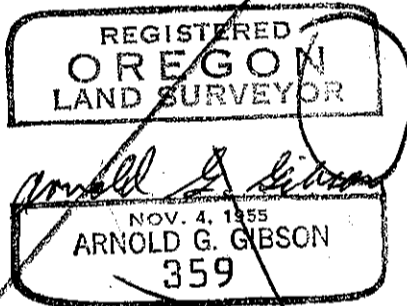
24" Fir bears $N83^{\circ}E$ 64.2 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S30 BT RS 359.
