RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Center one-quarter corner in Section 30,
T3S, R9W, W.M.; Tillamook County, Oregon.

ESTABLISHED 1887 (see county records)

30" Fir bears S62°W 60 lks. now 55" stump scribes
¼ S BT Visible.

30" Fir bears N62°E 92 lks. now missing (found remains
of roots and large hole N62°W 92 lks.)

RESTORED

Var. 21½°E

Set 1½" X 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY C¼ S30 1957 RS 359,"
35 inches in ground, in E-W fence line, and from which a:

1"x31" iron rod bears West 10.0 feet; 25" in ground and
in E-W fence line.

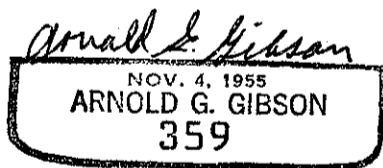
1"x40" iron rod bears East 10.0 feet; 22" in ground and
in E-W fence line.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on
fence post 3.6 ft. west.

Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 2 feet east of pipe.
