One quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 30,  
T. 3N, Rgs. 5 and 6 W, W.M., Tillamook and Washington  
Counties, Oregon.

(No evidence of original corner found)

REESTABLISHED

Var.  $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap  
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S25 S30  
1957 RS 359," 34 inches in ground, in mound of stone,  
and from which a:

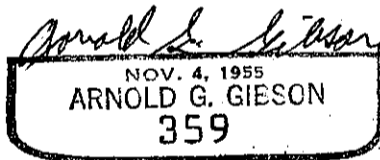
- 10" Fir bears S34°W 1.5 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S25 BT RS 359.
- 6" Fir bears S28°E 40.5 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S30 BT.

6" Fir BT.

Set 3"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NW of pipe.
