RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One Quarter corner common to Sections 15 and 16,
T. 1S, R. 8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

10" Hemlock bears $N41^{\circ}W$ 14 lks.; now 24" stub 4' high, face
and scribes rotted off.

8" Hemlock bears $N64^{\circ}E$ 23 lks.; now 16" stub 4' high,
scribe S visible on partially exposed face.

RESTORED

Var. $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S15 S16 1957 RS401,"
33 inches in ground, and from which a:

11" Fir bears $N56\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 64.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S16 BT RS401.

7" Spruce bears $S43^{\circ}E$ 51.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S15 BT.

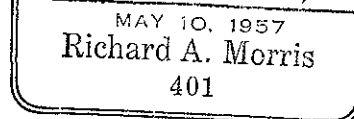
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4"

post 1.0' SE of pipe.
