 Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0' W of pipe.

South One Sixteenth corner for Section 7 (West side),

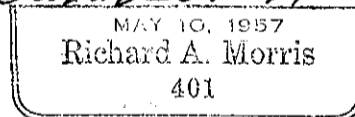
