REESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
(See official plat)

One Quarter corner common to Sections 33 and 34,
T2S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

(No evidence of original corner found)

Var. 21 1/2 E

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S33 S34 1959 RS401", 26 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

28" Hemlock bears N84E 38.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S34 BT RS401.

44" Cedar bears N87W 44.7 ft.; scribed 1/4 S33 BT.

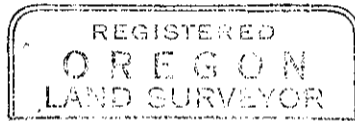
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 28" Hemlock BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 55" white painted Cedar post 1.0' NW of pipe.

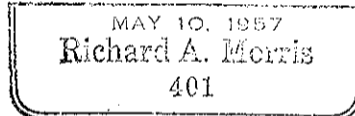
Corner is on N. edge of a 64" Cedar snag.
