RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 26,  
T2S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

No evidence of original corner found, (see affidavit by Harold Williams  
filed at Tillamook County Surveyor's office) found 3" x 3" x 48"  
Cedar post N7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 8.0 ft., scribed 1/4 S26 & 1/4 S25.

RESTORED

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE  
BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S26 S25 1959 RS401", 33 inches in ground, in small  
mound of stone, and from which a:

- 7" Hemlock bears S29 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 51.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S25 BT RS401.
- 5" Hemlock bears N69W 13.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S26 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 11" Alder N45E  
3.0 feet.

Set 4" x 4" x 50" white painted Cedar post 1.0' S.E. of pipe.

AFFIDAVIT

Tillamook, county


I, Harold Williams, of Bay City, Oregon, being first duly sworn, do  
depose and say as follows:

I am fifty-seven years old and have been a timber cruiser for the  
last thirty-five years. I saw the one quarter corner common to  
sections 25 and 26 T.2S. R.9W.W.M. in 1918, 1919, 1925, 1927, 1933  
and 1934 while working for the Whitney Co. Ltd. and the Dye and  
Riechers Logging Co. With a copy of the original notes I found a  
cedar bearing tree with scribes visible. It was destroyed by logging  
in 1938. I also saw a large spruce, which was approximately 30  
feet north of the corner point, with evidence of two old faces on it,  
which now is a stump with old axe work on it. Richard Morris  
placed a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with a 3" bronze cap, furnished  
by the Oregon State Board of Forestry, at the point where the  
original corner set.
