

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36,
T7S, R2E, W.M., Marion County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 14 x 14 x 8 (found in place, 5 notches on North and West, 1 Notch
on South and East) from which a:

Fir BT bears S66W 45.5 ft.; now 36", exposed portion of B2 scribe. (This
BT not recorded in original field notes.)

RESTORED

Erected mound of stone around corner stone from which a:

- Original 36" Fir bears S66W 45.5 ft.; scribed BT RS526 (on outside).
- 22" Fir bears S79E 15.5 ft.; scribed T7S R2E S36 BT.
- 18" Fir bears N83E 5.8 ft.; scribed T7S R2E S25 BT.
- 22" Fir bears N10W 16.7 ft.; scribed T7 S R2E S26 BT.

Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted Cedar post 1.5' NE of corner stone.
Marked X on top of stone.
