

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter section corner common to Sections 13 and 11, Township 2 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing from which a:

10" Hemlock bears N65°W 43 lks.; now 2 ft. stub badly burned and rotted.

13" Hemlock bears S30°E 51 lks.; now 14", down, roots in place, BT scribe visible.

RESTORED CORNER AND NEW BEARING TREES.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY ¼ S14 S13 1953 2311," 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone and from which a:

42" x 30 ft. Fir stub bears S56°W 38.4 ft.; scribed ¼ S RE 2311 BT.

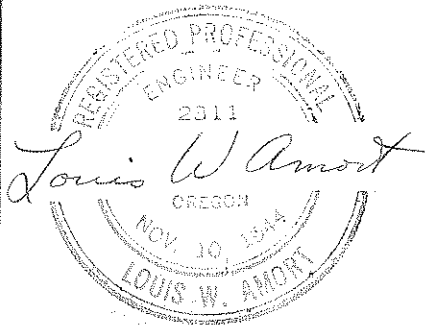
60" Fir stump bears S45°30'E 57.4 ft.; scribed ¼ S BT.
