

CHAINS

ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  
(see official plat)

East one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 33 and 4, Townships  
1 & 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked  
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY E 1/16 S33 S4 1953 2311,"  
10 inches below top of roadway, 10 feet East of center line,  
and from which a:

69" Fir stub 30 ft. high bears N51°30'W 78.4 ft.; scribed  
E 1/16 S33 BT.

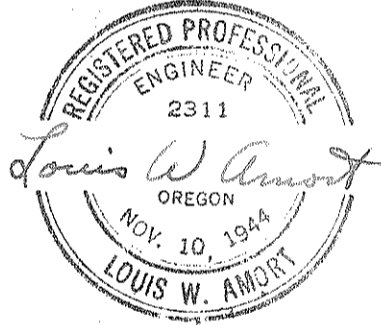
84" Fir stump bears S29°E 42.3 ft.; scribed E 1/16 S4 BT  
RE 2311.

1 1/2" x 40" galvanized iron pipe 40" in ground with 3" bronze  
cap bears N89°29'30"W 35.0 ft.; marked E 1/16 S33 S4  
RM 1953 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 4" x 4" x  
48" white cedar post next to RM. Also poster on 84" Fir stump  
BT.
