

CHAINS

REESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

One quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 1 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S4 S3 1953 2311," 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which as:

54" Fir stump bears N60W 188.1 ft.; scribed 1/4 S4 BT RE 2311.

54" Fir stump bears N42°30'E 157.2 ft.; scribed 1/4 S3 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 54" Fir stump BT N42°30'E. Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 1.6 ft. N15W of pipe. Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on east bank log road N88°48'52"W 125.0 ft.
