

CHAINS

ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

Center North one-sixteenth corner common to Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 C ——— C S3 1953 2311," 37 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 20" Fir snag bears West 39.9 ft.; scribed CN 1/16 S3 BT.
- 51" Fir snag bears N83E 120.9 ft.; scribed CN 1/16 S3 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 20" Fir snag BT.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on ridge N15°30'W 258.5 feet.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on ridge S15°30'E 810.9 feet.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 1.0 feet East of pipe.
