

CHAINS

ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

Center one-quarter corner common to Section 3, Township 1 North,
Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1½" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY C 1/4 S3 1953 2311," 15 inches
in ground, next to roots on South side 28" Fir snag, in
mound of stone, and from which a:

- 42" Fir stump bears S55E 6.8 ft.; scribed C 1/4 S3 BT.
- 32" Fir stump bears S19W 30.3 ft.; scribed C 1/4 S3 BT RE
2311.

- Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on South
side 28" Fir snag.
- Also poster on white cedar post 2.5 ft. south of pipe.
- Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on ridge N15°30'W
662.0 ft.

200.0 ft.
- Also poster on 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post on ridge N89°30'W
