

CHAINS

REESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

(see official plat)

One quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 33, Townships 1 and 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1 1/2" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S33 S4 1953 2311," 36 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

78" Fir stump bears N5°30'E 17.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S33 BT RE 2311.

16" cedar snag bears S44°30'E 78.6 ft.; scribed 1/4 S4 BT.

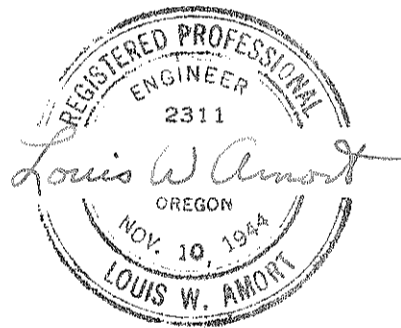
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 78" Fir stump BT.
