

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 10, Township 2 North,
Range 6 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 8" Hemlock bears S55E 48 lks.; now missing.
- 24" Fir bears N54W 48 lks.; now 31" stump, scribe 1/4 visible.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" X 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S3 S10 1953 2311,"
32 inches in ground, in small mound of stone, and from
which a:

- 36" Fir stump bears N64E 23.5 feet.; scribed 1/4 S3 BT
RE 2311.
- 7" Fir bears S50E 10.8 feet.; scribed 1/4 S10 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 36"
Fir stump BT.
Also C-Z poster 600 feet east on east edge road.
