

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, Township 2 North,
Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

17" x 14" x 9" stone (in place) from which a:

15" Hemlock bears S35W 59 lks.; now 20" snag scribes 1/4
S visible.

16" Hemlock bears N47W 16 lks.; roots in place.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S5 S8 1953 2311,"
30 inches in ground on south side original stone, in mound
of stone, and from which a:

60" Fir snag bears N68E 45.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S5 BT.

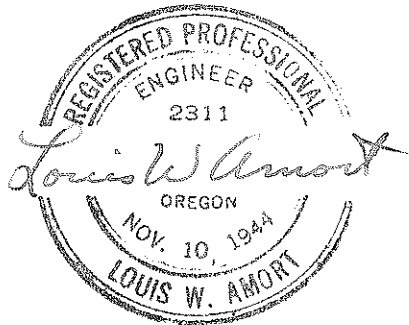
74" Fir stump bears S69°30'W 39.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S8
BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 74"
Fir stump BT.

Also C-Z poster 1215 feet south on north edge log road.
