

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 26, 27, 34 and 35, Township 3 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 24" Hemlock bears N13E 14 lks.; now 34" stub 20' high, scribes T3N R visible.
- 48" Fir bears S82E 50 lks.; now 54" stump, face not cut out.
- 20" Hemlock bears S67W 54 lks.; now 28" snag, scribes R7W S34 T visible.
- 40" Hemlock bears N48W 45 lks.; now 48" snag, scribes T3N R7W S27 BT visible.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3N R7W S27 S26 S34 S35 1953 2311," 32 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 20" Hemlock bears S80E 73.0 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S35 BT RE 2311.
- 6" Hemlock bears N73E 32.4 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S26 BT.
- 47" Fir stump bears N26°30'W 34.5 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S27 BT.
- 48" Fir stump bears S88°30'W 19.1 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S34 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on original 48" Fir BT.

Also poster on new 48" Fir stump BT.
White cedar post 1.5 feet southwest of pipe.
