

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

East one quarter corner common to Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 18" x 14" x 7", now missing, from which a:

- 24" Hemlock bears N40W 16 lks.; now 24" stump, portions of  $\frac{1}{4}$  BT scribes visible.
- 18" Hemlock bears S82E 20 lks.; now one foot high root stub.

RESTORED

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S24 1953 2311," 36 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 28" Fir bears S83 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 36.6 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S24 BT RE 2311.
