

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section closing corner common to Sections 18 and 19, Township 2 North, Range 6 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 12" x 10" x 8" marked cc on East edge and 3 notches on North and South edges, from which a:

24" Hemlock bears N25 1/2 E 70 lks.; now 36" stump, bears N28 1/2 E BT scribes visible.

24" Hemlock bears S75 E 48 lks.; now 50" triple stump, 2N R6W S19 BT scribes visible.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" x 40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2N R7W S13 T2N S18 S19 R6W CC 1953 2311," 30 inches in ground, on south side original stone, in mound of rock, and from which a:

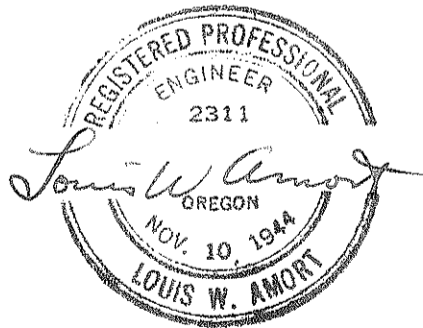
22" Fir stump bears N65 1/2 E 88.4 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S18 CC BT RE 2311.

28" Fir stump bears S2 1/2 E 51.5 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S19 CC BT.
