

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 4 and 5,
Township 1 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County,
Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 30" Hemlock bears S58E 27 lks.;
now 40" stub 30 ft. high,
scribes $\frac{1}{4}$ " S BT visible.
- 30" Hemlock bears S45 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 27 lks.;
now 40" snag, scribes $\frac{1}{4}$ " S BT visible.

RESTORED

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze
cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY $\frac{1}{4}$ "
S4 S5 1953 2311," 30 inches in ground, in
mound of stone, and from which a:

- 56" Fir stump bears S36E 35.6 ft.;
scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ " S4 BT.
- 84" Fir stump bears S14W 63.6 ft.;
scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ " S5 BT.
