SLOBT RS359.

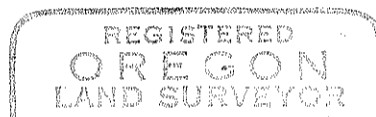
47" Fir bears N76°W. 76.7 ft.; scribed CW 1/16

26" Fir BT.

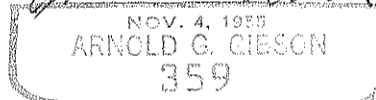
Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of
