35 inches in ground and from which a:

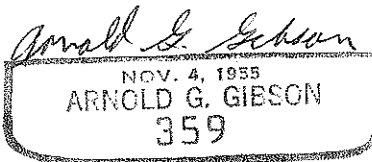
- 72" Fir stump bears N27°W. 43.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S10BT
- 96" Cedar stump bears N86°E. 51.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S11
