Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked  
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S10 C-----C S10  
1956 RS359," 35 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and  
from which a:

45" Fir snag bears N $56^{\circ}$ E. 131.8 ft.; scribed CN 1/16  
S10 BT RS359.

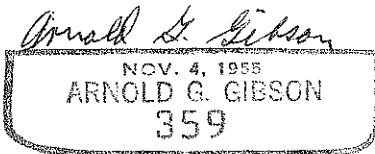
19" Fir stub 18 ft. high bears S $21^{\circ}$ W. 24.8 ft.;  
scribed CN 1/16 S10 BT.

Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted cedar post 1.8 ft. SE of pipe.
