ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  
(See official plat)

Center one quarter corner of Section 10, T. 1N., R. 7W., W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon

ESTABLISHED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked  
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY C¼ S10 1956 RS359,"  
35 inches in ground, and from which as:

60" Fir stump bears N58°E. 4.9 ft.; scribed  
C¼ S10BT RS359.

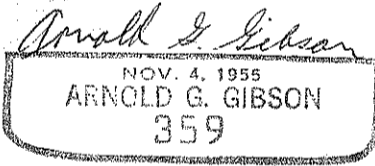
57" Fir snag bears S36°E. 95.6 ft.; scribed  
C¼ S10 BT.

Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted cedar post 2 ft. NW of pipe.
