ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

West One Sixteenth corner common to Sections 5 and 8, T. 3S., R. 7W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

ESTABLISHED

Var. 21-1/2° E.

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY W 1/16 S5 S8 1957 RS359," 35" in ground, in mound of stone, under west side of 48" Fir log, and from which a:

41" Fir stump bears S.54°W. 36.0 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S8 BT RS359.

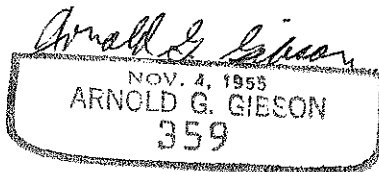
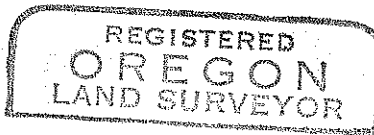
84" Fir stump bears N.54°E. 36.0 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S5 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 41" Fir stump B.T.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 3.0' S.W. of pipe.
