ESTABLISHED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
(See Official Plat)

Witness one quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 35,
Tps. 3 & 4 N, R. 8W, W.M., Tillamook & Clatsop Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

(No evidence of original witness corner or of meander corner
on West bank was found)

ESTABLISHED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY WC ¼ S35 S2
1956 RS 359," above road on East bank Nehalem River
187.9 ft. S89°13' W of corner point, 33 inches in
ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

13" Hemlock bears N31°W 31.0 ft.; scribed WC ¼ S35 BT RS 359.

60" Fir stump bears S62°W 15.1 ft.; scribed WC ¼ S2 BT.

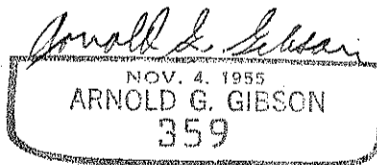
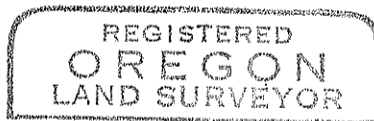
Set 4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1ft. NE of pipe.
