

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9,
T. 3S., R. 7W., W.M., Tillamook, County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 12" x 10" x 8" (now missing, point falls in slide area)
from which a:

- 8" Fir bears N23 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E 38 lks.; now missing, point falls in slide area.
- 30" Hemlock bears S20 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E 63 lks.; now 35" stub 15" high, scribe 9 visible on edge of burnt out face.
- 3" V. Maple bears S54°W 9 lks.; now missing.
- 18" Cedar bears N42 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W 41 lks.; now 17" stub 7" high, face and scribes burnt off.

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ °

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3S R7W S5 S4 S8 S9 1956 RS 359," 34 inches in ground, in small mound of stone, and from which a:

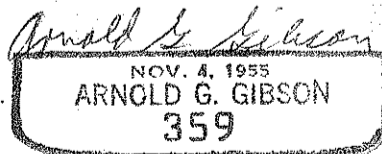
- 61" Fir stump bears N3°W 21.3 ft.; scribed T3S R7W S5 BT RS 359.
- 39" Cedar stump bears N35°E 62.9 ft.; scribed T3S R7W S4 BT.
- 43" Cedar snag bears S32°W 112.3 ft.; scribed T3S R7W S8 BT.
- 48" Fir snag bears S10°E 94.9 ft.; scribed T3S R7W S9 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 43" Cedar snag BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NW of pipe.
