ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY
(See Official Plat)

Center West one-sixteenth corner of Section 11, T1S, R8W, W.M.
Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY CW 1/16 C---C S11 RS 359,"
33 inches in ground, and from which a:

50" Fir stump bears S9°E 12.4 ft.; scribed CW 1/16 S11 BT
8" Alder bears N40°W 8.6 ft.; scribed CW 1/16 S11 BT
RS 359 (in bark)

Set 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of pipe.
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 8"
Alder BT.

Also poster on 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 546 ft. S on
N edge Wilson River Highway.

Also poster on 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 444 ft. E on
E edge Coast Range Road.

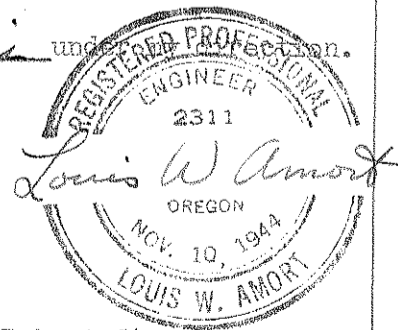
