RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One Quarter corner common to Sections 7 and 18,
T3S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing) from which a:

- 4" Fir bears N77W 200 lks.; now 29" Fir, scribes 1/4 S visible, lower face unexposed.
- 3 1/2" Maple bears S49 1/2 W 136 lks.; now missing.

RESTORED

Var. 21 1/2 E

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S7 S18 1960 RS401", 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

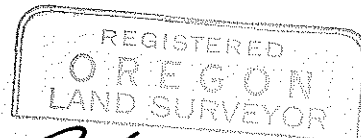
- 20" Fir bears S46 1/2 W 28.2 ft.; scribed 1/4 S18 BT RS401.
- 24" Fir bears N4E 34.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S7 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 20" Fir BT.
Set 4" x 4" x 56" white painted Cedar post 1.5' S.W. of pipe.

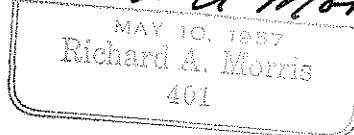
