- Set a spruce limb post 6 ins. diam. 24 ins. high mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. and $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 on S. side.
Also I set a stone 12x6x6 mkd. X on top and $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face 12 ins. beneath the surface of the ground on N. side of post, from which
- A 30" spruce mkd. by some previous survey, bears S. 9° W. 18.5 ft. mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S. I mkd. additionally,
 - A 70" sp ruce stump bears S. $12^{\circ} 30'$ E. 145 ft. slope dist. to scribed face of stump mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 BT.
 - A 102" sp ruce stump bears S. 43° W. 223 ft. slope dist. to scribed face of stump, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 BT.
- No tree in sec. 31 convenient to mark.

Set $\frac{1}{2}$ in. pipe and wired old stake to pipe.
- A 10" fir, bears S. 40° E. 1.5 ft. mkd. T 4 S R 9 W S 23 BT.
 - A 14" fir, bears S. 16° W. 10.5 ft. mkd. T 4 S R 9 W S 22 BT.
 - A 16" fir, bears N. 22° W. 19.7 ft. mkd T 4 S R 9 W S 15 BT.
 - An 8" fir bears N. $55^{\circ} 30'$ E. 15.2 ft. mkd T 4 S R 9 W S 14 BT.
