

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 30 and 31 (West end), T1S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 16 x 10 x 4 (in place in East & West fence line, 1 notch on South, 4 on North - 1 broken off, in small mound of stone, and in dense Salmonberry thicket) from which a:

20" Spruce bears N25E 30 lks.; now 60" stump, original axe work (77 years old), distance 39.5 feet.

No other trees available (which is still true).

Spring branch, SE, bears North 60 lks.; in place.

Same branch bears East 1.00 chains; in place.

NOTE: Another stone 5 x 6 x 12, marked SC bears West 157 feet from which a: 28" Hemlock bears S27E 14.0 ft.; east of portion of knife scribe B remains, approx. 50 yrs. old.
20" Alder bears N57 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 16.5 ft.; evidence of old face.

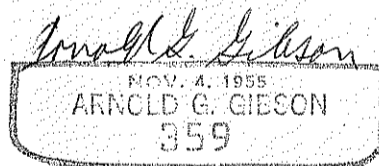
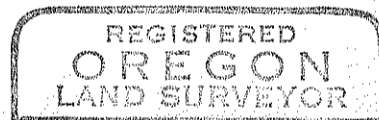
Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NE of corner stone from which a:

60" Spruce stump (original) bears N25E 39.5 ft.; scribed T1S R8W S30 BT RS359.
