

CHAINS

WITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner for Section 5 (North boundary), T3S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing, 1" iron pipe in place - see affidavit by Mrs. Pearl A. Moore, July 9, 1964)

12" Hem.bears S65E 7 lks.; now missing, point falls on the edge of road.

12" Spruce bears North 23 lks.; now missing, point falls in fence line.

Note: 1" I.P. pointed out by Mrs. Pearl A. Moore of Pleasant Valley, Oregon, is 4 feet South of the centerline of a road that bears East and West.

WITNESSED

28" Cedar bears S86 1/4 E 211.7 ft.; scribed 1/4 S5 BT.

13" Fir bears N51 3/4 W 33.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S32 BT RS401.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 8.1 ft. South of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 13" Fir BT. Also poster on white painted Cedar post.
