A hemlock, 6" diam., bears S.11°W., 14 1ks. dist.

Found 3" x 3" wood stake 8" above ground in poor condition with mks rotted away. Found small knots on post cut off by axe. In my opinion this is a remnant of the original post.

Found 33" spruce stub, S.74°E., (not 68°E., as in orig. notes) 15 lks. with visible mks S1. Found 18" rotted hemlock stub, S.7°W. (not S.11°W., as in orig.notes) 14 lks. with visible mks "BT".

The N.W. and N.E. BT are gone.

I set 1½" galv. pipe 5 ft. above ground.

I mark New BTS

6" hemlock, N.31° 30'W., 39 lks. mkd T4SR11WS35 BT.
4" hemlock, N.7°E., 16 lks. mkd X BT. - one foot above ground.
43" spruce, S.30°W., 39 lks. mkd T6SR11WS2 BT.
