

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 17, Township 3 South, Range 7 West, W. M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing) from which a:

12" fir bears N 53 E 37 lks.; now 37", /4 S visible on partially exposed face.

8" Alder bears S 78W 13 lks.; now 26", face and scribes unexposed.

RESTORED

Var 21 1/2 E

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S16 S17 1966 RS 707", and from which a:

18" Hemlock bears N 43E 22.4 ft.; scribed 1/4 S16 BT.

26" Fir bears S 38 W 47.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S17 BT RS 707.

37" Fir (orig.) bears N 53 E 24.4 ft.; scribed BT.

29" Alder (orig.) bears S 78W 8.6 ft.; scribed BT (in bark).

Set 4" x 4" x 50" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NE or cornerpipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 18" Hem BT. Also poster on east edge Elk Creek Road S 89° 48' E 1583.9 ft.
