A basalt boulder, 10 x 3 x 3½ ft. above ground, bears N. 65° E., 34 lks. dist., mkd. B-10 on the top near the W. end.

A wild cherry, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 49½° E., 65 lks. dist., mkd. T4S R7W S5 BT.

A wild cherry, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 83° W., 91½ lks. dist., mkd. T4S R7W S6 BT.

A forked alder, 35 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 162 lks. dist., bark scribed T3S R7W S31 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, alder, fir, wild cherry, cascara and maple; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, fern, huckleberry, willow, and devil's club.

N. 89° 56' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Ascend 5 ft. along N. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

0.50 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 35 ft. over broken NW. slope.

4.50 Bottom of descent, slopes N.; asc. 15 ft. over NE. slope.

7.30 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 330 ft. over NW. slope.

19.50 Gravelled road, 35 lks. wide, bears N. 7° E. and S. 7° W.

19.715 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31.

Set an iron post, 12 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, the top 8 ins. below the surface of the ground, the base on solid rock mkd. with a cross, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 3¼° E., 340 lks. dist., mkd. E1/16 S31 BT.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 80½° E., 205 lks. dist., mkd. E1/16 S6 BT.

The corner is located in the W. edge of the road.

Descend 80 ft. over NW. slope.

21.20 Left bank of Nestucca River, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.

21.75 Nestucca River, 70 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; asc. 15 ft. over rocky river bottom.
